

An Important Notice to Paul Kane Parents

After school hours on Wednesday February 17th, a threat was received that appeared to be targeted towards a Paul Kane High School staff member. The threat was said to occur on Monday, February 22nd, 2016. We are not releasing the details of the threat, as it is presently under investigation by the St. Albert RCMP.

On Monday when students arrive at the school, there will be an RCMP presence in the building. We ask that all students use only the front doors of the school for entering and exiting the building. Classes on Monday will progress as usual.

It is unfortunate that someone has chosen to communicate something that is threatening to the school. We encourage parents to have a conversation with their child, and if they have any further information that would help us with our investigation, please encourage your child to come forward.

We take the security of our students and staff very seriously. The precautions that we have in place at Paul Kane represent a level of response that St. Albert Public Schools and the RCMP believe are necessary. The safety of our students and staff is our primary goal.
